Week 1 - Growing into the Image of Jesus

Sunday, September 11: 2 Corinthians 3:15-18

Pray that God will continually transform us into the likeness of Jesus Christ. Ask God to help you see ways in which you can make practical strides toward becoming more like Jesus.

Monday, September 12: Matthew 16:24

Pray that we may have the faith to deny ourselves and to take up our cross to follow Jesus. Pray that as we follow Jesus, we will come to see people more like He sees people.

Tuesday, September 13: Ephesians 5:1-2

Pray that God will help you follow His example as you strive to imitate Him. Pray that God will give you the strength and courage to "walk in the way of love," which is the way of Jesus.

Wednesday, September 14: Matthew 18:2-4

Ask God to show you how to take the humble position of a child. Appeal to God for a heart that can shun the self-centeredness and arrogance so prevalent in our broken world.

Thursday, September 15: Hebrews 5:11-14

Pray that we may be ever-maturing disciples and that everything we do as a church leads to spiritual growth.

Friday, September 16: Romans 8:28-29

Pray that we may continually submit to God in faith in order that we may become conformed into the image of His Son. Pray that we may encourage our brothers and sisters as they also submit to God in faith.

Saturday, September 17: Galatians 2:20

Pray for God to help us become more cognizant of the truth that Christ lives in us.

Week 2 - Holding to the Word of God and Prayer

Sunday, September 18: 2 Timothy 3:16-17

Offer thanks to God for Scripture and ask Him to help us hold strong to the Word. Tell Him specific reasons you're thankful for the Word of God.

Monday, September 19: Hebrews 4:12

Pray that we can read and study Scripture with humble, open hearts. If your heart has been hardened to the Word, ask Him to soften or break it, so that His Word can penetrate your soul.

Tuesday, September 20: Psalm 1

Pray that we can be like the "tree that is planted by streams of water" by our devotion to the Word of God. If you're not in the habit of reading the Word, ask God for Him to help you change so that spending time in the Word becomes a daily activity.

Wednesday, September 21: 2 Timothy 4:2

Pray that our elders, teachers, and ministers can teach and preach the Word passionately and effectively. Pray that they will love the Word, listen to it, and apply it in their own lives as they share it with others.

Thursday, September 22: Philippians 4:4-7

Do you present your requests to God *in every situation*? What's going on in your life that you can share with God today? Who will you take before the throne in prayer today?

Friday, September 23: Matthew 6:9-15

Pray for forgiveness, deliverance from evil, and for God's will to be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Pray for the Leander Church to display God's will in our community so that more people will come to know Jesus.

Saturday, September 24: Acts 4:23-31

Pray for faith that God will work in mighty ways in this church and that we will have the eyes to see how He works for His glory and purposes.

Week 3 - Cultivating Youth & Family Discipleship

Sunday, September 25: Deuteronomy 6:1-9

Pray that our families will cultivate an atmosphere of spiritual learning and growth as they come up with creative ways to teach Godly principles to their children.

Monday, September 26: Proverbs 22:6

Pray for those who are raising children in this congregation, that they may be able to effectively teach and train their child to put them on the right path.

Tuesday, September 27: 2 Timothy 1:5, 3:14-15

Who is a Lois and Eunice in your life? Who taught you the Gospel? Pray for the people who cultivated discipleship in your life and also that you may lead others into a deeper relationship with Christ.

Wednesday, September 28: Luke 14:25-35

Pray for those in the church, both young and old, who are currently counting the costs about being Jesus' disciple. Ask God to give them strength, courage, and hope. Ask God to also give you the same things as you continue to live your life as an example of others.

Thursday, September 29: Ephesians 6:1-4

Pray that parents will lead their children towards a relationship with Christ and that their children will look up to, honor, and respect their parents.

Friday, September 30: Ecclesiastes 12:1

Pray for our children and youth that they may come to know their Creator in real and tangible ways so that their faith may remain strong as they grow older. Also, reflect on all the times God remained faithful to you despite your shortcomings; Thank Him for that!

Saturday, October 1: Ephesians 2:19-22

Pray that our church comes to realize that we are all one big family and that we have a responsibility towards one another. Pray for the Holy Spirit to live and be active in our church family as we continue to grow together.

Week 4 - Engaging in Life-Changing Worship

Sunday, October 2: Isaiah 6:1-13

Pray that our worship services can so impact us that we are moved to confession, repentance, and a deeper understanding of our God.

Monday, October 3: Hebrews 10:24

Pray that as we continue "meeting together" on Sundays, we will see those gatherings as opportunities to encourage our brothers and sisters in their faith journeys.

Tuesday, October 4: Ephesians 5:18-20

Pray that while we sing together as a congregation, our hearts will be engaged in pouring out praise to God. Ask God to help our song leaders lead with hearts that are worshipful, humble, and grateful to God.

Wednesday, October 5: Psalm 100

Pray that our worship to God will remind us of who God is and, in turn, who we are in relationship to Him. Pray that we may be humble and grateful as we come together as God's people to worship.

Thursday, October 6: Psalm 29

Pray that we will come to the understanding that we are the participants, God is the audience, and He is the King of kings worthy of our praise and adoration.

Friday, October 7: Psalm 95

Pray that as we worship together our joy will be evident to all around us and that our worship will be expressive of the thanksgiving that is in us due to the great gift we have been given in Jesus Christ.

Saturday, October 8: John 4:23-24

Pray that as we approach the throne of God we will truly worship deeply in Spirit and in Truth so that we will be "true worshippers" of our mighty God.

Week 5 - Sharing Life as a Grace-Filled and Diverse Community

Sunday, October 9: Acts 2:42-47

Pray that we may experience the joy of living in fellowship with other Christians and that we may experience the same kind of camaraderie and love by our Christian brothers and sisters of the first century.

Monday, October 10: Ephesians 4:1-6

Ask God to help us, by the work of the Spirit, to "be patient" with one another as we "bear with one another in love." Ask God to empower you to be an instrument of peace within the church family.

Tuesday, October 11: John 13:34-35

Pray that the Leander Church will be full of disciples determined to love one another as Jesus taught. Ask God to show you clear ways you can show love to others in our congregation.

Wednesday, October 12: Psalm 133

Pray that God will bind us together in love so that we can experience the goodness of living in unity, while sharing in His blessings. Pray that God will open your eyes to specific ways you can be a promotor of unity in the church.

Thursday, October 13: Romans 12:9-13

Pray that we may become more observant of opportunities to be hospitable and to share with those in need. Thank God for the gift of being a member of the body of Christ where all participants are devoted to one another.

Friday, October 14: 1 Corinthians 13:1-3

Ask God to fill us with His love. Thank God for His love for us – a love that is witnessed most clearly in His Son. Pray specifically for those who need to see God's love in action.

Saturday, October 15: James 1:27

Pray that we as a church may keep in mind what is most important and to fervently practice it together. Pray also that God will help you remain pure and unpolluted by the world.

Week 6 - Loving Our Neighbors Near & Far

Sunday, October 16: Matthew 23:37-40

Pray that we can love in this way. Offer thanks to God for His love for you. Ask God to give you tangible opportunities to show His love to others.

Monday, October 17: Luke 10

Pray that we, like the Good Samaritan, can be merciful and neighborly toward others. Ask God to give us eyes to see those around us in need and to have the courage to do something about it.

Tuesday, October 18: Matthew 28:16-20

Pray that we may take Jesus' commission to heart and share the Gospel with others. Pray for your friends and neighbors who do not know Jesus yet, asking God for opportunities to share the Good News with them.

Wednesday, October 19: Acts 1:8

As people empowered by the Holy Spirit, pray that we will witness to others concerning the gift of salvation offered through Jesus. Pray specifically for the Leander and Cedar Park area.

Thursday, October 20: 1 John 3:16-18

Pray that God will stir our hearts in such a way that we offer our love to others through God-honoring actions. Pray that God will open doors for you to show His love to those who need it.

Friday, October 21: 2 Corinthians 5:16-21

Pray not only that you become reconciled to God, but also that the entire world may become reconciled to Him. Ask God for courage to boldly represent His kingdom as ambassadors here on this earth.

Saturday, October 22: Matthew 5:43-48

Part of what it means to love our neighbors is to love those who don't love us back. A step towards loving your enemies is to pray for them, whoever they may be. So spend time praying over your enemies.
