The Vision Implementation “Team’s” purpose is to ensure that the Leander Church of Christ is actively and intentionally moving toward our vision under the direction of our shepherds.

The Team has been hard at work! We know you cannot always see what is going on behind the scenes, so we provide congregational updates to help better keep you informed. With much prayer and consideration, the Team has been active in:

- Assessing the effectiveness of current ministries and programs in living into the vision
- Devising a plan for effective implementation of ministries that will ensure that the congregation is being true to the vision
- Assessing resources (personnel, facilities, equipment, training, etc.) for the various ministries to ensure that they are properly equipped for achieving the vision.

Highlights of the team’s recent work:

- New Young Adults Bible Class. The Vision Team worked alongside Darrell Hutson, Education Minister, to begin a class designed for young adults and families. The class began in May meeting in Room 4. As of this month, Howard Kirk is teaching this class. The Senior Adults Bible Class graciously moved rooms to make space for this group.
- Worship Coordination. The Vision Team worked alongside Jim Nicks, Vernon Montgomery and Josh Waley to ensure that worship leaders are prepared each week for the important task of leading worship. There is a higher level of communication between all parties involved in the service. The hope is for a thoughtful and prepared worship service each week.
- Transformative Bible Class. Darrell Hutson constructed the “Transformative Bible Class” that he began implementing this past fall in an effort to create more structured classes and deeper relationships with one another.
- Life Groups. Michial Meyer and Howard Kirk are leading a team to assess our Life Groups and provide changes as needed to reinvigorate Life Groups. The team hopes to provide the congregation with a plan early spring.

- Facilities Project. Team members include Howard & Courtney Kirk, Dan Walker, Whit Pennock and Richard Benskin. They did an extensive assessment of the facilities, reviewed congregational input and had an inspector assess the facilities to compile a thorough list of the wants and needs of our congregation. Our facilities need to support the vision in doing God's work. The first order of business is addressing safety, accessibility and maintenance issues. This work has already started, plus, a congregational work day will be coming up in the near future. The team expects to have a full plan for our facilities to share with the congregation this spring.
- 12 Months of Prayer. 2018 is a year of change and growth in our church family, so we are asking everyone to spend time in prayer. Each month for the rest of the year, we will have a specific request that you and your family can pray about. For February, we ask that every pray about our Preacher Selection Process and the man that God will bring to us. *Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. -Colossians 4:2*
